Reflection:



The journey to Jerusalem is ended. Jesus is in the temple, the very center of Jerusalem. Jesus' end is near. Attention turns to the end.

In the month of November when we pray for those who have died, Jesus' resurrection and the promise of our resurrection fills us with hope and confidence.

'The last three Sundays of the year invite us into the future. Though we are accustomed to think of the close of the Liturgical Year as the end, it is really an opening into the end-time, into the future. Each of the remaining Sundays flashes a spotlight on some aspect of what God is doing in preparation for this future.

Today we look briefly at the question of the resurrection and the character of the life we are to live in anticipation of or in fidelity to it'.

THE WORD

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON: Let my prayer come before you, Lord; listen, and answer me.

RESPONSORIAL PSALM: Lord, when your glory appears, my joy will be full.

V. 1. Lord, hear a cause that is just, pay heed to my cry.

Turn your ear to my prayer: no deceit is on my lips. **R.**

V. 2. I kept my feet firmly in your paths; there was no faltering in my steps.

I am here and I call, you will hear me, O God. Turn your ear to me; hear my words. **R.**

V. 3. Guard me as the apple of your eye. Hide me in the shadow of your wings. As for me,

in my justice I shall see your face and be filled, when I awake, with the sight of your glory. **R.**

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION: Alleluia, alleluia! Jesus Christ is the firstborn of the dead; glory and kingship be his for ever and ever. Alleluia!

PRAYERS OF THE FAITHFUL: With hope, we pray: Lord, hear our prayer.

Advent Richard McKinney Ecumenical Lectures 2010:

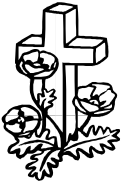
The theme for the lectures is: 'Challenging Teaching? - Matthew's Gospel'
