#### Fr Len Thomas - A Reflection

Last Monday morning I arrived at St Bernadette's Church around 8.00am as I usually do. I was very much aware that on June 20 we would be celebrating the retirement of Fr. Len Thomas. The readings for this Sunday express much about Len and his life as a priest in the Archdiocese of Melbourne.

My mind began to think of all the priests I have had the privilege of working with over the years. Like myself, many of us have struggled with the slings and arrows of outrageous fortune and the human condition. I know that Len has a great concern for fellow priests and has been a source of encouragement and strength for many priests in times of struggle.

In the past Len was involved in the areas of Propagation of the Faith for many years, and his outreach in the area of Ecumenism is legendary. Len has been a source of hope for many people – people of all faiths, and no faith. Many people in our parish have been encouraged and strengthened by Len's gentle and caring presence, and supported by his very practical wisdom.

Len's acceptance, welcome and respect to all people gives hope to our world. Len has been hospitable to all who call upon him and has maintained regular contact with those in need. So many people in our society – even young people – suffer from mental illness, and I know that Len has been a beacon of hope to them, their families and friends. Len's work in the area of Mental Health has been significant not only in our parish, but in many areas of our country – especially through Centacare. Len has been most significant in the life of the parish since 1999 at a variety of levels.

Len, too, has been involved in Rotary, and that work will continue well beyond his retirement. Once again, many people will benefit from his kindness, practical wisdom and outreach to others.

When I arrived in Ivanhoe ten or eleven years ago, I was a little lost. Len through his wisdom and understanding enabled me to survive. Len was most helpful and supportive to me in so many ways – by attending meetings and celebrating Masses, as well as offering advice and encouragement.

Len, on behalf of all here today, and on behalf of all who are no longer with us, we thank you for so much:

- Your great faith
- Your generosity and kindness

- Your willingness to listen
- Your great wisdom and humanity

(But Len, why don't you barrack for Collingwood!)

These words from Paul Gardner SJ in regard to Mary MacKillop's biography remind me of Fr Len Thomas: 'Love did not depend on performance. She looked at beyond what she could see, hear or smell – and attended to what her faith told her of the dignity of every human person.' — Fr John
